- COVID-19 Checklist Guidance (7/1)
 - Guidance for License-Exempt Day Camps that covers:
 - ✦ Group Size (50)
 - ✦ Sanitation and Infection Control
 - ✦ Restrict Access
 - ✦ Signage
 - ✦ Health Screenings
 - ✦ Arrival/Drop-off - Modified sign-in/sign-out procedures.
