Federal Updates



- Senate released HEALS Act:
 - \$15 billion for child care
 - ✦ \$5 billion to child-care providers
 - ✦ \$10 billion for “back to work child-care grants”

Federal Updates



- FY 2021 Appropriations:
 - The LHHS bill increases 21st CCLC by \$13 million
- House Passed Two Child Care Bills:
 - Child Care is Essential Act (providing \$50 billion for CCDBG)
 - Child Care for Economic Recovery Act (increases mandatory CCDBG funding and expands child care tax incentives and deductions)

Federal: Take Action!



Afterschool Alliance, the Bipartisan Policy Center, and others called on Congress to include at least **\$6.2 billion** in 21st Century Community Learning Center afterschool program support.
