Quality reporting begins long before your due dates. Set your after-school organization up for success by establishing systems for data collection and tracking, considering both quantitative and qualitative reporting requirements. Trainer's Corner

- **Reminder: Attendance Records:** When attending training sessions, please keep in mind that the BOOST Team is monitoring session attendance and assigning credit based on the collected data. You must attend 75% of the session to obtain credit for each training. If you join by phone, or if you and a colleague join using the same account information, the BOOST team may reach out to determine which members of your staff attended. We suggest that attendees join separately whenever possible and use personally identifiable names to ensure the accuracy of our attendance records.
