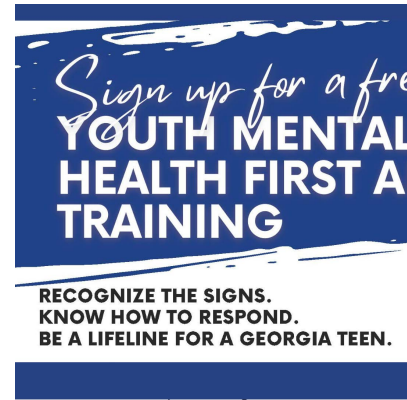

**24% of Georgia's youth aged 3 – 17 years had one or more mental, emotional, developmental, or behavioral problem.** Youth Mental Health First Aid (YMHFA) teaches individuals how to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental health challenges among youth. 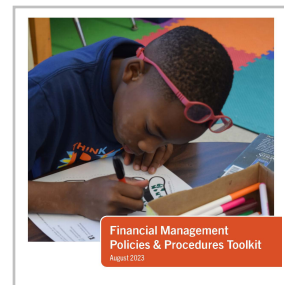
