## Statewide Funding Opportunity: 2024 Learning Loss Grant



United Way of Greater Atlanta and the Georgia Division of Family and Children Services have collaborated to reduce COVID-induced learning loss by implementing a statewide competitive grant for a third year. The [2024 Learning Loss grant](#) will provide awards of up to \$50,000 to support community-based organizations in Georgia who are reducing learning loss for low-income youth through building reading skills, improving math proficiency, supporting school transition, strengthening family engagement, supporting learning acceleration, increasing access to quality out-of-school time and contextualizing learning.

**Applications open December 11, 2023.** To apply, organizations must complete a registration in the Fluxx portal by **January 11, 2024** to gain access to the application and submit the full application by **January 18, 2024**. Applicant information sessions will be held on **December 6 at 2pm** and **December 7 at 11am**.
