As we move into the final stretch of the FY26 program cycle, we want to take a moment to acknowledge the steady commitment and care you have put into your programs this year. From implementation to reporting, your consistency continues to move this work forward in meaningful ways.

This is an important closeout period, and staying aligned on final deadlines and expectations will help ensure a smooth transition into FY27. As always, we appreciate your partnership and responsiveness.

Here's what to keep top of mind:

FINAL INVOICE AND GADOE PAYMENT UPDATES



Due to the migration of the state management system, GaDOE Grants Accounting has updated the payment schedule. Moving forward, payments will be issued once per month, rather than weekly.

Each cycle includes a Grant Payment Pull Date, which requires that your invoice application is fully approved through all steps in advance.

What to know:

- Invoices **must be submitted to GaDOE by 1:00 PM** on the pull date
- Invoice applications are reviewed at 2:30 PM on each pull date
- Grantees should carefully **follow the guidance** outlined in their invoice approval notice **from GSAN to ensure timely submission** and avoid delays
- Any invoice not fully approved by 2:30 PM will be processed during the next payment cycle

Tip for Success: Submitting your final invoice early increases the likelihood of timely payment. Waiting until the final pull date may result in delays, including payment not being processed until after the summer.

FY26 Final Payment Timeline

June 11, 2026 (Thursday)

- 1:00 PM: Invoice submission deadline to GaDOE
- 2:30 PM: Final review and payment pull

June 18, 2026 (Thursday)

- Final Payment Issued

Important: If a drawdown request is submitted after June 11, **it will not be paid until August 20, 2026.**

This is your time to stay informed, ask questions, and prepare for what's ahead. Please ensure your organization is represented.

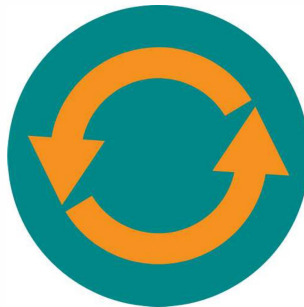

Q4 Implementation Report - Due June 19, 2026



The Q4 Implementation Report is the final report for the FY26 program cycle.

Quarterly report #4 will open June 1, 2026, within the BOOST Grants Portal (powered by Submittable). Failure to submit this report timely and accurately by the due date could result in a delayed approval of your FY27 budget and initial invoice payment.

Tips For Success:

- The report is **cumulative** from the start of your program
- You must use the site form template embedded within the report form. Please remember to input these details for each site entry:
 - o Program type (afterschool, summer, both)
 - o Site address and county

- Youth served numbers should reflect the number of unduplicated youth who attended your program
- You may indicate no updates if applicable
- Please ensure all submitted data is accurate and complete
